Dear Parents.

The students had a wonderful week celebrating learning during Literacy and Numeracy Week last week. They were involved in many special activities that promoted and raised awareness of the importance of reading, writing and mathematics skills. Thank you to all of the parents who joined us for the Reading Café open morning and for visiting our Enrichment Showcase and Travel Expo.

#### **Home-School Partnership**

Improved student learning occurs when parents, teachers and students work together to ensure the best social, emotional and academic outcomes for the child. We maintain an open door policy at Albanvale PS and welcome and encourage parents to come in and discuss your child's learning, or to address any concerns you may have. We ask that you assist us in building an environment where mutual trust and respect is valued.

Should you wish to speak to your child's teacher, please make an appointment to see them, as often before school at 8:45am or straight after school at 3:15pm are not ideal times due to teachers preparing for instruction or attending meetings. Please note: Meetings with any staff member, including leadership, will be by appointment only.

#### Administration Centre - Nexus Hub

Our new administration centre has been in full operation this term. The building is lovely and new and offers our school community a large administration office, sick bay and meeting rooms. Earlier in the term we ran a competition to name the building and the winning name staff decided on is **Nexus Hub**. Nexus means 'connection' and Hub means 'centre'. New 'Nexus Hub' signage will be installed on completion of the landscape works around this area.

#### Sun Smart Policy

In line with the DET Sun Smart Policy and to ensure student safety from UV rays, students are required to wear their school hats from now until the end of April as UV rays are considered highest during these months. Parents, please ensure your child has a navy blue wide brimmed slouch hat at school for the beginning of next term. Children not wearing hats will be required to sit in the designated shaded area and will not be allowed to participate in outside play.

#### **School Fees**

School fees are now overdue. School fees incorporate extra-curricular activities such as Sports Awareness; therefore payment must be made for student participation in this program, as the school is required to pay external providers. We request payments be made as soon as possible. Thank you for your understanding. Payments are requested by **Friday 13**<sup>th</sup> **September**. Families experiencing difficulties in paying school fees and would like a payment plan option, are requested to let the office know.

#### **Bullying**

Bullying is repeated verbal, physical, social or psychological aggressive behaviour by a person or group directed towards a less powerful person or group that is intended to cause harm, distress or fear. At Albanvale P.S bullying of any sort will not be tolerated. Should you have any concerns regarding your child being bullied please consult your child's teacher, Mr Uzunovski or myself. Each matter is followed up thoroughly to ensure every student at Albanvale P.S feels safe.

There are also behaviours, which, although they might be unpleasant or distressing, are not bullying:

- mutual conflict which involves a disagreement
- single-episode acts of nastiness or physical aggression
- social rejection or dislike is not bullying unless it involves deliberate and repeated attempts to cause distress, exclude or create dislike by others.

Students at Albanvale PS are expected to act responsibly, act safely and show respect. Students who demonstrate challenging behaviours will need to accept responsibility for their behaviour and will be given consequences as a result of any unacceptable behaviour. It is important parents work with the school to ensure a safe and happy environment for all.

#### Student Grade Placements 2020

Teachers will begin the process of placing children in grades for 2020 early next term. This is a very long and thorough process with much consideration given to ensuring that each individual child's needs are met. Students will have an opportunity to complete a friendship list and will be placed in a grade with at least one friend. Teachers will refer to this list, as well as their current knowledge of the child, before allocating your child to a class for next year. Our aim is to create an environment in each classroom that promotes optimal learning. Teachers spend considerable time and effort creating grades, which cater for the educational, social and emotional needs of all children. Should your child have any specific needs that you wish to bring to my attention in regard to grade placement, could you please make an appointment to discuss these with me by Friday 25<sup>th</sup> October.


Parents/Garers – have you moved recently or changed your phone number? Let us know and we will update your details so we can keep you up-to-date!

You can log your child's absence by logging onto the COMPASS app or call the school absentee line on 9367 2197.


