### Dear Parents,

Our school swimming program commences next week and will run over two weeks. The Victorian Government has allocated funding over the next two years to support Victorian government primary schools to deliver swimming and water safety as part of the Victorian Curriculum. The funding will assist students to achieve their Victorian Water Safety certificate, a base level of swimming and water safety competency, before leaving primary school. The Certificate is awarded when a student can swim 50m continuously, answer water safety based questions and perform simple rescues.

Our **grade 3-6's** will be the first year levels to attend from 25<sup>th</sup> until the 29<sup>th</sup> November and the **grade** Prep-2's will attend from 2<sup>nd</sup> until the 6<sup>th</sup> December. It is important to remember to mark your child's clothing with their name and to provide a bag for them to store their wet clothing.

### School Review

### Student Grade Placements 2020

Teachers have begun the process of placing children in grades for 2020. This is a very long and thorough process with much consideration given to ensuring that each individual child's needs are met. Students had an opportunity to complete a friendship list and will be placed in a grade with at least one friend. The teacher will refer to this list, as well as their current knowledge of the child, before allocating your child to a class for next year.

Our aim is to create an environment in each classroom that promotes optimal learning. Teachers spend considerable time and effort creating grades which cater for the educational, social and emotional needs of all children.

All students will be involved in a whole school transition day on **Tuesday 10**<sup>th</sup> **of December** whereby they will be informed of their 2020 grade, teacher and classroom.

### **Healthy Food**

We encourage children to eat food that is good for their brain development. Please assist us by providing healthy food for their snacks and lunches each day. This will help their brain function for thinking and learning. Whilst Albanvale Primary School is fortunate to be supplied with apples from the Food Bank organisation, children are still encouraged to bring fruit in their lunch box each day.

### <u>Uniform</u>

Whilst the end of the year is approaching, we would appreciate your assistance in ensuring that a high standard of uniform is maintained. School uniform promotes a sense of identity, pride, cohesion and good order in a school. It allows students to feel equal and enhances individual student safety and group security, as well as enhancing the profile and identity of the school and its students within the wider community. The School Council Policy of Albanvale PS states that uniform is compulsory for the students of Albanvale. It is important that parents are vigilant in ensuring. Please note: Socks must be worn with closed shoes. Jeans or leggings under dresses are not allowed.

You can log your child's absence by logging onto the COMPASS app or call the school absentee line on 9367 2197.



Council's second Pop-Up Drive Through Recycling Day will be held at Victoria University in St Albans, on Saturday 30 November from 8am-1pm.

The first event in March was a huge success with over 360 residents participating and more than 21,000 kilograms of items were collected on the day.
