Dear Parents,

The students have had a wonderful week celebrating learning during Literacy and Numeracy Week. They have been engaged in many special activities that have promoted and raised awareness of the importance of reading, writing and mathematics skills.

Home-School Partnership

Improved student learning occurs when parents, teachers and students work together to ensure the best social, emotional and academic outcomes for the child. We maintain an open door policy at Albanvale PS and welcome and encourage parents to come in and discuss your child's learning, or to address any concerns you may have. We ask that you assist us in building an environment where mutual trust and respect is valued.

Should you wish to speak to your child's teacher, **please make an appointment** to see them, as often before school at 8:45am or straight after school at 3:15pm are not ideal times due to teachers preparing for instruction or attending meetings. Please note: Meetings with any staff member, including leadership, will be by appointment only.

Sun Smart Policy

In line with the Department and our school's Sun Smart Policy and to ensure student safety from UV rays, students will be required to wear their school hats from (1st September) until the end of April 2020, as UV rays are considered highest during these months. Parents, please ensure your child has a navy blue wide brimmed slouch hat at school. Children not wearing hats will be required to sit in the designated shaded area and will not be allowed to participate in outside play.

School Fees

School fees are now overdue. School fees incorporate extra-curricular activities such as Sports Awareness; therefore payment must be made for student participation in this program, as the school is required to pay external providers. We request payments be made as soon as possible. Thank you for your understanding. Payments are requested by **Friday 6**th **September**. Families experiencing difficulties in paying school fees and would like a payment plan option, are requested to let the office know.

Prep Enrolments 2020

Prep Enrolments for 2020 students are being finalised now for children who live in the Albanvale Primary School zone. If you have any children who will be attending Albanvale in 2020 or know of any families of prep age children, please call or visit the school to receive enrolment information. It is important for planning purposes that all prep 2020 students are enrolled as soon as possible.

Proof of age (birth certificate or passport)

Immunisation certificate from Medicare

Please let the office know if your child is leaving the school at the end of this year, so that we may begin the transition process for your child with their new school.

<u>Attendance</u>

Thank you to those families who have contacted the school administration when their child has been genuinely unwell and unable to attend school for the day. We appreciate your support in providing an explanation for the absence.

Is regular attendance at school important? Yes – from the first day. If your child misses the basic skills in primary school they can experience difficulties with their learning.

Regular attendance is essential to make sure learning is not disrupted.

Regular learning provides building blocks for the future.

Schools help children to develop important social skills, such as friendship building, teamwork, communication skills and a healthy self-esteem.

Remember: Our goal is a "FULL HOUSE" (100% attendance) in all classrooms every day. It is not OK to be away!






