Dear Parents and Carers,

With the easing of restrictions the Department of Education has announced that staggered school start and finish times will cease and schools will now resume regular school hours. Starting next week, students are expected to commence school at 9.00am and will finish at the regular time of 3.15pm. Students MUST still enter and exit from their allocated gates and NO parents are to enter the school grounds at this stage.

### **Library Books**

As we are now getting close to the end of the year, this is the perfect time to have a look around at home for library books and perhaps take home reading books which may be hiding. We are always excited to see lost materials returned. Please return any Albanvale Primary School library books you find to the school by 4<sup>th</sup> December.

### **Whole School Transition Day**

All students will be involved in a whole school transition day on **Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> of December** whereby they will be informed of their 2021 grade, teacher and classroom.
Teachers have spent many hours forming grades to ensure we meet the social, emotional and academic needs of all students.

Tuesday the 8<sup>th</sup> of December is also the day that our current Year 6 students visit their new high schools. Our Year 6 students are currently involved in a transition program to prepare them for high school and are feeling confident about attending their transition day.

During orientation programs all schools must ensure they meet Department of Health and Human Services' (DHHS) coronavirus (COVID-19) health and safety advice. Programs must be adapted, with all arrangements — subject to updated public health advice.

All students attending Orientation Day are required to wear face masks (some <u>exceptions may apply</u>). This will be a new experience for Year 6 students, who are not required to wear face masks in primary school.

### 2021 Prep Transition Day

We are pleased to advise that our 2021 preps will be able to attend the whole school transition day on **Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> December.** We are still finalising the details of how the program will run and anticipate that we will advise families of the arrangements next week.

If you have not finalised the enrolment for your child into prep for 2021, or know of any family / friends that may not have enrolled yet, please do so as soon as possible so that we may include all of our students in the Prep Orientation Day Program and support them with their transition to school.

#### Uniform

Whilst the end of the year is approaching, we would appreciate your assistance in ensuring that a high standard of uniform is maintained. School uniform promotes a sense of identity, pride, cohesion and good order in a school. It allows students to feel equal and enhances individual student safety and group security, as well as enhancing the profile and identity of the school and its students within the wider community. The School Council Policy of Albanvale PS states that uniform is compulsory for the students of Albanvale. It is important that parents are vigilant in ensuring. Please note: Socks must be worn with closed shoes. Jeans or leggings under dresses are not allowed.

### Illnesses

In order to keep our students and school community safe, Albanvale Primary School are being vigilant with the health of students and staff. A reminder to parents that **children who are unwell should not attend school**. If your child displays any of the following symptoms they must be kept home and seek medical advice:

dry cough	conjunctivitis
	conjunctivitis
tiredness	headache
aches and pains	loss of taste or smell
difficulty breathing	sneezing and runny nose
, 0	sore throat

While many of these symptoms are similar to that of hay fever or asthma, students must still be kept home and be tested for COVID as a precautionary measure. A hay fever or asthma management plan should be developed in conjunction with your family doctor.

### Please note:

If your child is absent due to illness, it is a required that you advise the school via the COMPASS app or by calling the office with an explanation regarding the absence.

Where a child presents ill at school no matter how mild the symptoms present, they will be appropriately isolated and parents called to collect them.




